

## ARTICLE III

### Committees of the Senate

Senate Committees shall be composed as follows:

1. Each committee will consist of at least five Senators, one from each of the divisions of the College. The Executive Committee may choose to appoint additional members to one or more committees.
2. At least two members of each committee will have served on that committee in the previous year.
3. No member of any committee shall serve for more than three consecutive years on any given committee.
4. During the April meeting of the Senate, the chairs of each committee for the following year will be chosen from those members who have served on the committee previously.
5. A full slate of committee appointments will be put together by the Executive Committee over the summer and ratified by the Senate at the first meeting of the new session in August. **Newly appointed Senators will be asked to submit a rank-ordered list of committees they would prefer to serve on, which the Executive Committee will use to recruit new members. To help inform prospective members, each Committee Chair will submit a brief explanation of their committee's functions, goals, and recent activities to the Executive Committee following the April meeting.**
6. **Committees will meet during the August meeting of each year to discuss priorities and acquaint new members with the duties and expectations of the committee.**
